

Raw Materials



The torrefaction process will take different varieties of biomass and



convert them to a homogeneous material which can be densified and the burned along side coal.

Raw materials to be used include waste wood, slash, pole wood not otherwise used in the lumber industry, including bark as well as



grown on purpose energy crops such as switch grass and hybrid willow and poplar. Wood that has little of no market value within the timber industry can be used in this process.
